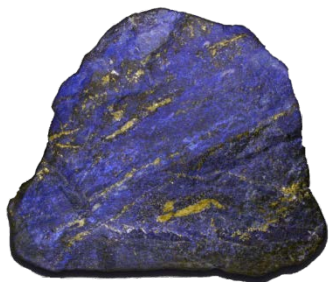

Who We Are

Founded in 1966, the Geoscience Information Society (GSIS) facilitates the exchange of information in the geosciences through cooperation among librarians, geoscientists, publishers, editors, and other information specialists.

The Society includes both national and international representation from academia, businesses, publishers, governments, societies, and other organizations. Members represent all aspects of the geosciences and address the wide range of information issues faced by those working in the field.

GSIS is a member society of the American Geosciences Institute (AGI) and an associated society of the Geological Society of America (GSA).

Our Annual Meeting is held in conjunction with the GSA every autumn, and includes forums, oral and poster presentations, a business meeting, a luncheon, a field trip, a reception, and an exhibit booth in the GSA hall.

Members are encouraged to present posters or papers at the Annual Meeting. The abstracts of the accepted papers are published in the GSIS Proceedings of the Annual Meeting, as well as indexed in GeoRef.

Awards

At the Annual Meeting, GSIS presents the following annual awards for outstanding contributions in the geosciences: The Mary B. Ansari Best Geoscience Reference Work Award, the Distinguished Service Award, the Best Paper Award, the Best Website Award, the Best Guidebook Award, and Outstanding Geologic Field Trip Guide Series Award.

Publications

GSIS has an active publication program that includes a quarterly newsletter, the Proceedings of the Annual Meeting, and the Membership Directory.

The Society also issues *Guidelines for Authors, Editors, and Publishers of Geologic Field Trip Guidebooks* and compiles resources on Open Access in the Geosciences.

Since 1968, the Society has published the Union List of Geologic Field Trip Guidebooks of North America, which is now available online as the Geologic Guidebook of North America Database.
